1. a Understanding that the word barbless means without the sharp part of the hook is essential for answering this question correctly. The image next to the last paragraph shows a hook without the barb. Also, the reference in the paragraph to careful release along with barbless hooks gives the impression that fishermen who do these things care about maintaining the fish population.

2. a The logical prediction is that the number of fish caught decreases because of all the trend graphs only the graph illustrating **the total fish caught and retained** shows a steady decline in the number of caught and retained fish since 1985. The other trend graphs do not support the suggestions made in the other answer options.

3. c Draw students attention to the purpose of the asterisk as a connection to a footnote or extra information provided by the writer for clarification.

4. c The introductory paragraph does contain information related to the last paragraph, however, it is not enough to generate the percentage information given in the last paragraph. The trend graph "**Total fish caught and retained**" is the only graph which provides the information required to generate the percentage comparison statements made in the last paragraph.

5. a Encourage students to replace the word **adopted** in the sentence with each of the words in the suggested answers and then reread the sentence. They should choose the word that does not change the meaning of the sentence.

6. d The "**Direct fishing-related expenditures**" graph provides information about the kinds of things anglers spend money on to participate in this recreational activity (draw student's attention to the information beside the asterisk below the graphs) . These expenditures contribute to Canada's economy .
