1. Use hwcdsb.schoolcashonline.ca to pay \$40 fee by February 25th . Cash also accepted. No cheques accepted.
2. Choose your courses using myPATH by March 1st .
3. Those registering for Co-op: You will Register with priority on February 24th and 25th . You can also register at any time. Co-op students: Print out your backpack and indicate your area of co-op preference.
4. Bring your proof of Activity fee payment and a copy of your backpack to your Block 1 class for in-school registration.
5. Online students will show proof to their Block 1 teacher virtually.
