PROGRAM INFORMATION

Secondary Math Prep Courses

- 10 math concepts covered in 10 days
- Some days to review key concepts from prior grade
- Some days to introduce key concepts for upcoming grade
 - For example, a student entering grade 10 in September 2021 would take the Grade 10 Math Prep Course to review concepts from Grade 9 and introduce concepts from Grade 10
- Will include a blend of synchronous and asynchronous learning so access to an electronic device each morning is strongly recommended
- The same program will be offered in both July and August
- Registration ends June 25th, 2021

Secondary Literacy Prep Course

- 10 day program will address the following skills: reading, writing, and research, test preparation
- Students will explore and use a variety of tech tools
- Preparation and practice for the OSSLT
- Will include a blend of synchronous and asynchronous learning so access to an electronic device each day is required.
- The same program will be offered in both July and August
- Registration ends June 25th, 2021

Christian Service Hours Opportunities

- The Christian Service Volunteer Program is an innovative platform that allows HWCDSB secondary students to have the opportunity to sign up for eligible Christian Service volunteer opportunities in their community. The Christian Service Program allows students to become active stewards in their community and encourage them to accumulate their 40 Community Service Volunteer Hours required to complete their Ontario Secondary School Diploma.
- The COVID-19 Pandemic created extreme barriers to allow students to volunteer normally in their community. However, the HWCDSB created and hosted many virtual volunteer opportunities to assist community organizations and allow secondary students to volunteer virtually in their communities.
