1. Use hwcdsb.schoolcashonline.ca to pay \$40 fee by February 27th . Cash also accepted. No cheques accepted.
2. Choose your courses using My Blueprint by March 1st.
3. Those registering for Co-op: You will Register with priority on March 1st . You can also register at any time. Co-op students: Print out your Sign off sheet and indicate your area of co-op preference.
4. Bring your proof of Activity fee payment (digital or printed) and your Sign off sheet (digital or printed) to your Period 1 class for in-school registration.

COMPULSORY COURSES

Be sure to pick a minimum of 6 courses including these compulsory courses:

- Religion (HRT4M1 or HRE4O1)
- English (ENG 4U1 or ENG 4C1 or ENG4E1)
- Although Grade 12 math is not a compulsory, many programs will list it as a prerequisite or as a recommended course. Choose carefully.
- Don't forget your 40 hours of Community Service!!!
