Important Information for Students:

- Students are not to required to report to school on scheduled exam days that fall on their lunch period or spare. Students are asked to stay home and study on such days;
- If you are at school for extra help on a non-exam day, you must be in full uniform;
- In the event of school closure or cancellation of transportation, the schedule will be delayed by one day (i.e., Monday exams will be moved to Tuesday and so forth until the examination cycle is completed);
- If an emergency occurs at school (i.e. power failure), direction will be given by the Principal with regards to resuming or rescheduling the exam;
- Students are encouraged to arrange for transportation home after completing exams. <u>Buses</u> <u>run at regularly scheduled times during exam week. (starting at 2:35pm).</u> In the event that you do not have a ride home after an exam is completed; the cafeteria is the study silent area where students should be.
- <u>All exams begin promptly at 8:15am.</u> Additional time will not be granted for those arriving late.

C. STUDENTS ARE RESPONSBILE FOR:

- Remembering the date, time, and location of each exam;
- Arriving to the examination room by 8:10am for a prompt 8:15am start time.
- Bringing necessary materials (pens, pencils, eraser, calculator, textbooks, any other items as instructed by your teacher);
- Bringing authorized materials only. Pencil cases, eyeglasses cases, calculator covers, cell phones and audio devices are not permitted;
- Ensuring a Parent/Guardian contacts the Attendance Office if students cannot report to school for their exam due to extenuating circumstances;
- In the event of an emergency (i.e., illness, hospitalization) medical documentation must be provided.
- Returning all textbooks and/or other loaned items (musical instruments, equipment, etc.) and;
- Arriving to school in **FULL UNIFORM** for exams. Students will not be permitted into the examination rooms out of uniform.

D. CAFETERIA/HALLS

- Cafeteria services are unavailable during an exam week.
- There will be **NO LOITERING** in the halls while exams are in progress.

E. ACADEMIC DISHONESTY

• Academic dishonesty during an exam will result in a mark of zero. Parents/Guardians will be notified in such situations.

F. STUDENT SERVICES

• Student Services will be available during the exam period starting 8:00am to 11:30am. Guidance counsellors will be available on a drop-in basis if a student requires a timetable change for semester 2.

G. BOOK COLLECTION

- Please follow the textbook return procedure established by your classroom teachers.
- Textbooks will be checked during the last week of classes by your classroom teacher. You must return the same books you were given at the start of the semester. A fee will be charged for damaged/loss of books.
